God's Word, the Bible, says:

GOD LOVES YOU

1. For God so loved the world, that he gave his only Son, that **whoever believes in him** should not perish but have eternal life. *John 3:16*
2. ...but **God shows his love for us** in that while we were still sinners Christ died for us. *Romans 5:8*

Does that sound like God loves you?

EVERYONE HAS A PROBLEM

3. ...for **all have sinned** and fall short of the glory of God. *Romans 3:23*
4. For the wages of sin is death, but the **free gift of God is eternal life** in Christ Jesus our Lord. *Romans 6:23*

It sounds like we all have a problem, doesn't it?

GOD HAS A SOLUTION

5. Jesus said to him, "I am the way, and the truth, and the life. **No one comes to the Father except through me.** *John 14:6*
6. ...everyone who believes in him receives **forgiveness of sins** through his name. *Acts 10:43*
7. ...if you **confess with your mouth** that Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, **you will be saved.** *Romans 10:9*

What do these verses say to you?

Now, according to God's Word:

- Are you a sinner? *Romans 3:23*
- Would you like to receive God's forgiveness? *Acts 10:43*
- Will you accept that God raised Jesus from the dead? *Romans 10:9*
- Will you openly declare with your mouth that Jesus is Lord? *Romans 10:9*
- Would you like to receive the gift of eternal life right now? *Romans 6:23*

The Bible, God's Word, promises if you will **believe in Him** and **receive the gift of salvation** He offers, He will **FORGIVE** my sin and make me a brand new person.

"Father God in Heaven, thank you for giving your Son, Jesus, to die on the cross in my place. I realize my sin has separated me from you. Please forgive me of my sins. I believe in your Son Jesus Christ. I believe you raised him from the dead. Today, I receive the gift of forgiveness. I now place my trust in Jesus. Thank you for the gift of eternal life.

Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation. The old has passed away; behold, the new has come. 2 Corinthians 5:17

This is the most important decision you will ever make. Let's review what you have done today:

- 1. Confessed** - Confession means to agree with God. When you confessed, you declared your desire to turn from your old way of thinking to a new way of thinking and living. This is what the Bible calls repentance.
- 2. Believed** - By asking His forgiveness, you were demonstrating your acceptance of who He is and what He's done for you.
- 3. Received** - As you received and opened your heart to Him, the Holy Spirit entered your life to take up permanent residence in you.

...God's love has been poured into our hearts through the Holy Spirit who has been given to us. Romans 5:5
